GO KIT SUPPLY CHECKLIST

Classroom “Go Kit” – Each room should have a “go kit” individualized to the age and needs of that room, here are some examples:

- ☐ Backpack or Bin labeled “Go Kit”
- ☐ Go Kit Supply Checklist
- ☐ Child Care Enrollment Form, including parent and emergency contact numbers
To be updated as necessary (these can be copies)
- ☐ Emergency reference flip chart for teachers
- ☐ Pen
- ☐ Take personal cell phone, if available
- ☐ Assorted Size Diapers
- ☐ Diaper Wipes
- ☐ Sippy cups & bottles
- ☐ Formula
- ☐ Snacks
- ☐ Extra Clothes in appropriate sizes
- ☐ Glow Sticks
- ☐ 2 Emergency Blankets
- ☐ Sanitary Gloves
- ☐ Face Mask
- ☐ Whistle
- ☐ Paper
- ☐ Crayons/Markers
- ☐ Games
- ☐ Books
- ☐ Small toys

Child Care Center “Go Kit” - This is a kit for the entire center and maybe kept on site and in off-site locations, for easy access, here are some examples:

- ☐ Container labeled “Child Care Center Go Kit”
- ☐ Student DCF Health History Forms & Emergency Contact Information
- ☐ Staff Emergency Contact Sheets
- ☐ Cell Phone with Charger (solar, auto or inverter)
- ☐ First aid kit
- ☐ Reflective vests with Center Name written on them
- ☐ Copies of Student Reunification Form (50)
- ☐ Clipboards (3)
- ☐ Pens (12+)

Go Kit Supply List

- ☐ Duct tape
- ☐ Copy of Emergency Operations and Crisis Response Plan
- ☐ Ream of white paper
- ☐ Flashlight and batteries/lantern/head lamps
- ☐ Radio (battery or hand crank) and extra batteries
- ☐ Garbage Bags and ties
- ☐ Paper cups, plates, plastic utensils, paper towels
- ☐ Water
- ☐ Package of Hand Warmers
- ☐ Package of instant cold packs
- ☐ 6 X 8 Tarp

Additional Items to consider:

- ☐ Teacher Buddy List
- ☐ Bullhorn and batteries
- ☐ 1'x2' piece of dry erase board (2)
- ☐ Black dry erase marker (2)
- ☐ Yellow caution tape
- ☐ Walkie-talkies: Take all that are available from your office
