## **Judging Record Books at the Club Level**

- 1. Please remember that children are doing these record books, not college students. Allow for a few mistakes, without counting them against the kids.
- 2. Overall, be positive, kids need encouragement and positive feedback. A few helpful constructive criticism comments can be included, but make sure the positive comments outweigh the negative.
- 3. Please take the time to include a few comments. A page of checkmarks is not helpful. Kids need to know how they can get to an award level.
- 4. Be aware that not everyone has excellent handwriting skills. If the required information is included in the record book, the quality of the handwriting should not be a factor in the judging.
- 5. There may be extenuating circumstances, such as a disability, that exist in certain families. Parents or club leaders, please alert the county record book judges about these circumstances. Judges will take these into account when they judge the book.
- 6. Record books need to have 6 or more very good ratings on the general construction area, 8 or more very good ratings on the project parts, and no needs improvement or missing/incomplete ratings in order for the record book to be considered eligible to go to the county level. A record book could go to the county for a single project if the member receives 8 or more very good ratings and no needs improvement or missing/incomplete ratings for that project.
- 7. Club Judging Sheets need to be removed from record books before going to the county for judging.
- 8. Please don't write in the record books. Note all of your comments on the scoring sheet.
