The Dodge County Meat Animal Sale Committee will be identifying Youth Market Beef, Market Sheep, Market Swine and Feeder Beef for the Dodge County Fair between *Monday, April 17 and 4:30 pm on Friday, May 5*. Junior Fair Market Beef, Sheep and Swine will be identified through tagging, DNA collection, and a 2023 Google Exhibitor/Family registration form. Feeder Beef projects will be identified through tagging and a 2023 google Exhibitor/ Family registration form (no weigh-in). We ask for your prompt attention to all the details of this identification process outlined below.

Instructions: Market Beef, Market Sheep, Market Swine ID tags, hair DNA sampling, and registration form.

1. Request and pick up your 2023 Market Animal Identification kit from the Dodge County Extension office. The kit will include the number of tags the exhibitor/family is requesting, hair DNA envelopes for each animal, and a link to an online registration - 2023 Dodge County Junior Fair Market XXX Registration Form. There is no cost. You are required to request your Identification packets with the Extension Dodge County office prior to pick up at 920-386-3790.

<u>In-Person request & pick-up day/April 29<sup>th</sup>.</u> The Dodge County Meat Animal Sale Committee will be hosting an in-person Market ID packet request and pick-up on Saturday, April 29<sup>th</sup> from 9 AM – 12 PM at the Dodge County Administration Building Auditorium at 127 E. Oak St., Juneau.

- Species will be separated by table for Beef (and Feeder Beef), Sheep and Swine.
- Request the number of tags your exhibitor/family needs. The tags, exhibitor letter, DNA envelopes and google registration link will be packed and marked for exhibitors.
- Sign off on clipboard that you have received packet.
- Taggers available for check-out if needed.
- Meat Animal Sale Rules and Dodge County Junior Fair Exhibits by Departments for questions.
- 2. Properly <u>collect</u> your animal's hair DNA sample. Hair collection how-to's are available on the <u>Extension Dodge County website</u>. Fill out DNA envelope (exhibitor name, tag #, date) and seal, one hair sample per envelope. Exhibitors should be present and helpful in tagging and DNA collection process.
- 3. <u>Tag</u> animal, with the provided Dodge County Fair identification tag.
- 4. Complete the appropriate market animal Google REGISTRATION FORM found at these codes.

The Meat Animal Sale Committee uses the data submitted to use at fair weigh-in, create show classes, and the Meat Animal Auction catalog. Once submitted you will receive an email receipt. Timestamps are collected for each submission. **Due by Friday, May 5, 2023 by 4:30 pm.** 

5. DNA collection envelopes are due to the Extension Dodge County office by the end of the business day (4:30 pm) on Friday, May 5, 2023, or by US Mail POSTMARKED no later than Friday, May 5, 2023.

## **Feeder Beef information**

Feeder Beef projects will be identified with ear tags and registration form. This will be in place of a weigh-in (NO FEEDER BEEF WEIGH IN). Feeder beef identification will occur at the same time as Beef, Sheep and Swine (*starting April 17* and registration completed by the end of business on May 5) \*\*

- Request your 2023 Feeder Beef ear tags from the Extension office. You are <u>required</u> to request your Identification packets (no dna collection with beef feeders) with the Extension Dodge County office prior to pick up at 920-386-3790.
- 2. Tag animal, with the provided Dodge County Fair identification tag.
- 3. <u>Complete</u> the Feeder beef REGISTRATION FORM found here.



Once submitted you will receive an email receipt. Timestamps are collected for each submission. <u>Due Friday, May 5,</u> 2023, by 4:30 pm.
