New this year, the Competitive Edge Conference and Scholarship program is open to high school juniors and transfer students (previously only open to high school seniors). They may attend again their senior year, in which they will be eligible to receive scholarships. Juniors are encouraged to attend to learn new skills and prepare for the transition to college along with all the other benefits of the Competitive Edge program.
