The dollars generated through the Dairy Youth Recognition Auction are carefully allocated to help as many 4-H, FFA and junior breed organization members in the Dodge County Dairy Project as possible. A total of \$176,400 in scholarships, funded by previous auctions, has been distributed to post-high school students who attend two and four-year degree programs.

Winners of this year's scholarships will be announced at the Dodge County Fair, just prior to the 2025 auction. Additionally, \$3,000 in grants are awarded to youth to assist them in purchasing a dairy animal.

The 2024 Auction Averaged \$2,465 Returned to Each Participant!

The remaining half of the bid dollars goes to the auction fund for dairy youth projects such as judging, dairy bowl, fitting and showing clinics and other activities.

Sixteen Dodge County Jr. Dairy Show youth earn an auction spot by achieving honors at the Dodge County Fair:

1. Best Registered Bred & Owned Cow
2. Best Registered Bred & Owned Heifer
3. Senior Champion Registered Holstein Female
4. Senior Champion Grade Holstein Female
5. Senior Champion of All Colored Breeds, Female (Grade or Registered)
6. Junior Champion Registered Holstein Female
7. Junior Champion Grade Holstein Female
8. Junior Champion of All Colored Breeds, Female (Grade or Registered)
9. Beginning Showmanship Winner
10. First Year Showmanship Winner
11. Junior Showmanship Winner
12. Intermediate Showmanship Winner
13. Senior Showmanship Winner
14. Top Junior Fitter
15. Top Senior Fitter
16. Education Card Lottery Winner

Each qualifying dairy show exhibitor is eligible to sell only one time per year. Alternates are the Reserve Champions or second place winners in non-Champion classes. All selections will be determined by the Dairy Youth Recognition Auction Committee.
