

## **The Kuhlman Family Dairy Promotion Scholarship**

The Kuhlman Family was one of the founding families of the Dodge County Dairy Promotion Committee, starting with Roy and Thirza Kuhlman in the 1970's. Their daughter Sandy was also an active member of the committee for many years. This scholarship is to honor the family for their work and dedication to dairy promotion in Dodge County. The goal of the Dodge County Dairy Promotion Committee is to help educate the public about the dairy industry through our annual Dairy Brunch on a Dodge County Dairy farm and through other activities in the community. Two scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$1000. Scholarships will be paid out to recipients following the completion of their Fall semester and upon proof of enrollment for Spring semester. The winners of the scholarships will be announced on our Facebook page prior to our Dairy Brunch. **The recipients are required to help for one shift at the Dodge County Dairy Brunch, which will be held on June 7th, 2026.** Previous scholarship winners are not eligible to receive a second scholarship from the Dodge County Dairy Promotion Committee.

**Eligibility:** The scholarship is open to high school seniors and all college students who have a strong passion for sharing their love of the dairy industry and will be or is currently pursuing a degree in an agricultural related field at a four-year university or technical college *OR* a student that will be or is currently pursuing a non-agriculture degree but has been a dairy project member in Dodge County 4-H or FFA for at least 2 years. Applicants must be a resident of Dodge County and must demonstrate leadership and dedication to promoting the dairy industry.
