

Dodge County 4-H Endowment Fund Scholarship

To be awarded in 2026: Scholarships in the amount of \$500 may be awarded. The number will be determined by the committee. If you receive the Patricia Hahn Legacy Scholarship, or the Harlan Hahn scholarship, you may not be eligible to receive the 4-H Endowment Scholarship.

Eligibility:

Any Dodge County 4-H member in good standing who is a 2026 graduating high school senior may apply. Applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll in an undergraduate college, university, or technical school for the 2026 – 2027 school year and working toward a degree.

Application:

Cover Letter

Not to exceed one page, with no less than ¾" margins and no smaller than 10 point font.

List applicant's name, contact information, 4-H club at the top of page.

Explain how 4-H made an impact on applicant's life thus far and how 4-H skills learned will be used in the future.

Resume

Not to exceed two pages, with no less than ¾" margins and no smaller than 10 point font.

List applicant's name, contact information, 4-H club at the top of page along with GPA.

Headings: Career goals, School experience including GPA, Work experience, 4-H experience (including years of membership), Leadership experience, Activities outside of 4-H.

List of 4-H projects in which applicant participated

Not to exceed one page, with no less than ¾" margins and no smaller than 10 point font.

List applicant's name, contact information, 4-H club at the top of page.

List projects in order of importance, with the most important at the top of the list, with number of years in each project.

List 4-H leadership activities and 4-H community service activities.

One letter of recommendation from current school year

From a teacher or 4-H leader (not a parent), to be submitted in a sealed envelope, together with the rest of the application. The letter should not exceed one page.

Application Due Date and Other Details:

1. All application forms and letters of recommendation should be submitted together, and must be received at Extension Dodge County, Attn: *Endowment Fund Scholarship*, 127 East Oak Street, Juneau, WI 53039 by 4:30 p.m. **March 1, 2026.**
2. Final selection of scholarship will be made by committee. All decisions are final.
3. Recipient will be notified in May.
4. Scholarship will be paid to recipient after sending Fall 2026 semester transcript showing successful completion of academic term to Dodge County 4-H scholarship committee (Extension Dodge County, Attn: *Endowment Fund Scholarship*, 127 East Oak Street, Juneau, WI 53039). Due by February 1, 2027.
